Addendum #5 (RV Parking Greater than 18')  
September 2, 2011

The following revisions, deletions and additions are hereby incorporated into the April 2010 IronHorse Design Guidelines:

1. Design Guideline, Page 49, (Residential Architectural Standards) Parking and Screening – Paragraph three (3):

*Campers, boats, boat trailers, recreational vehicles, recreational trailers, and other non-passenger vehicles, equipment, implements, or accessories in excess of eighteen (18') feet in length may be stored or kept on any improved homesite if the same are fully enclosed within the garage located on said improved homesite. Enclosures must be designed and constructed to be architecturally consistent with the home. The ARC must approve all such vehicle/trailer enclosures prior to construction. Campers, boats, boat trailers, recreational vehicles, recreational trailers, and other non-passenger vehicles, equipment, implements, or accessories of any size may not be stored on any unimproved homesite.*
